THE TWENTY FIRST OF MARCH NINETEEN HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE ACT NO. 2-53

AN ACT

Amending Chapter 20 of Title 21 of the Truk State Code by adding new sections, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Chapter 20 of Title 21 of the Truk State Code is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Chapter 20. Legislature Staff.

Section 311. Budget Officer. A position for a Budget Officer is hereby created. The Budget Officer shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Speaker. Duties and responsibilities of the Budget Officer shall be to assist in the preparation of the budget of the Legislature, assist the appropriate committees of the Legislature in the preparation of the Truk State Annual Budget. Other duties and responsibilities may be determined by the Presiding Officers of the Legislature."


Section 2. Amendment. Section 313 is renumbered as 310. Sections 314, 315, and 316 are hereby renumbered as 312, 313, and 314 respectively.

Section 3. Appropriation. The sum of \$15,000 is appropriated from the General Fund of the Truk State for the purpose of recruitment of the Budget Officer and the operation of his office and no obligations are to be incurred in excess of the sum appropriated by this section. The


Speaker of the Legislature shall be the allottee of the fund. The fund appropriated under this Section shall be expended in accordance with the Truk State Financial Management Act. Any part of this appropriation not obligated as of September 30, 1983, shall revert to the General Fund of the Truk State.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
