

SECOND LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TRUK

2ND REGULAR SESSION, 1ST SPECIAL SESSION, OCTOBER 1983 ACT NO. 2-88

AN ACT

To amend Section 2 of Title 29 of the Truk State Code to increase the sales tax, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Section 2 of Title 29 of the Truk State Code as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

"Section 2. Imposition. There is hereby levied on the first sale in Truk State, of all the tangible items, except medicine, baby food, and unprocessed and unpackaged items, as follows:

(1) Motor vehicles, including, but limited to, automobiles, jeeps, trucks, motorcycles, buses and motor-scooters, at the rate of five percent of the sales price;

(2) outboard and inboard motor engines at the rate of three percent of the sales price;

(3) jewelry, musical instruments, perfumes and cosmetics at the rate of three percent of the sales price;


(4) tobacco at the rate of thirty percent (30%) of the sales price;

(5) cigarettes at the rate of twenty cents (20¢) per pack of twenty; and


(6) all other items at the rate of three percent (3%) of the sales price."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the
Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.


