

SECOND LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TRUK

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, FIRST SPECIAL SESSION, NOVEMBER 1984 ACT NO.: 2-114

AN ACT

To amend Truk State Law No. 5-58, Sections 1 and 2, of the Truk State Living Standard Allowance, to provide that full-time and part-time public employees, as defined, including those employed with the U.S. Federal Programs, and those earning less than \$15,000 a year, should be eligible for the Living Standard Allowance, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Truk State Law No. 5-58, Sections 1 and 2 are amended as follows:


"Section 1. There is hereby established for Truk State a Living Standard Allowance. The Living Standard Allowance shall be paid to every full-time and part-time employee of the three branches of the Truk State Government, including those government employees who are employed with the U.S. Federal Grant Programs. The Living Standard Allowance shall be \$35.00 for each full-time and part-time employee in addition to his/her gross pay, per pay period. Except, all State Senators and all government employees of any type, earning a gross pay, exclusive of overtime pay, of \$15,000, or more, computed annually, should not receive this allowance."

"Section 2. Full-time and Part-time Employees Defined. All government employees working eighty regular hours or more in a bi-weekly pay period are full-time employees. ALL government employees working less than eighty regular hours in a bi-weekly pay period are part-time employees."


Section 2. Severability. If any provisions of this act, or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be retroactive to take effect on October 1, 1984, upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.


