

AN ACT

To amend Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 5-116, the Precinct Allocations, extending the reversion dates of unobligated funds of the precinct allocations, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 5-116, the Precinct Allocations, is amended as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the State of Truk, to be allocated based on the precinct allocations established by Truk State Law No. 3-6, to be allocated as follows:

Section 2. Extension of Reversion Dates. The sums appropriated by Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 5-116, remaining unobligated as of September 30, 1985, shall continue and remain available until the purposes for which they are appropriated are accomplished and completed, but until no later than September 30, 1986, during which any and all funds remaining unobligated shall revert to the General Fund of the State.

Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
