

AN ACT


To provide that all fines and penalties assessed by Truk State Courts for violation of vehicle laws as found in Title 83, Trust Territory Code, Chapter 1 through 7, shall be deposited in the General Fund of the State; to supersede Section 1021 of Title 6 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia to the extent of any conflict, and for other purposes.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

Section 1. Fines and Penalties to be Deposited in General Fund. All fines and penalties by courts established by the State Judiciary Act of 1982, Truk State Law No. 5-32, as amended, for violation of vehicle laws as found in Title 83, Chapter 1 through 7, of the Trust Territory Code, shall be periodically transmitted by the Administrative Director of Courts to the Truk State Department of Finance for deposit in the General Fund of the State.

Section 2. Supersedure. 6 Trust Territory Code §451, recodified as Section 1021 of Title 6 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Public Law No. 5-54 of the Fifth Congress of Micronesia) as it pertains to the assessment of fines for violation of vehicle laws as found in Title 83 Chapter 1 through 7, of the Trust Territory Code, is hereby superseded to the extent of any conflict with Section 1 of this Act.

Section 3. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
