

## AN ACT

To amend Truk State Law No. 5-116 as amended by Truk State Law No. 5-120, to change the use of the allocation provided to the 1st., 3rd, and 8th Election Districts and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 5-116, as amended by Truk State Law No. 5-120, is hereby amended by changing the use of 1st., 3rd., and 8th Election Precinct Allocation, to read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the State of Truk to be allocated based on the precinct allocations established by Truk State Law No. 3-6, to be allocated as follows:
