AN ACT

To establish qualifications for persons employed as attorney for the Truk State Legislature, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Any person employed as an attorney for the Truk State Legislature shall be a graduate of an accredited law school and admitted to practice law in any jurisdiction, and is a member of the Federated States of Micronesia or Trust Territory Bar.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
