AN ACT

To amend Section 52 of Chapter 3, Title 15 of the Truk State Code, as amended to provide for a member of the Committee on Education of the Truk State Legislature to serve on the State Scholarship Board, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State that:

- Section 1. Amendment. Section 52 of Chapter 3 of Title
- 2 15 of the Truk State Code, as amended by TSL No. 5-96, is

- 4 "Section 52. Scholarship Board.
- 1) Establishment. There is hereby established
 a Truk State Scholarship Board, which shall have the
 power to select qualified recipients to receive
 grants under this act, and shall exercise such other
 duties and powers as are provided by this act.
 - 2) <u>Composition</u>. The Scholarship Board shall be composed of five members, to be appointed as follows:
 - a) Two members to be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Truk State Legislature, or an appropriate committee designated for that purpose; and
 - D) Three members to be appointed by the Speaker, one of whom shall be a member of the Committee on Education of the Truk State Legislature.
 - members of the Scholarship Board shall be a period of three years, from the date of appointment provided that a vacancy on the Board shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as originally filled.

4) Removal.

a) Members of the Board may be removed from the Board for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office, by a three-fourths votes of all members of the Board.

4	5) Officers. The Board shall elect from
5 6	among its members a Chairman, a Vice Chairman ani
7	a Secretary during its first meeting. The Chairman

9	or in his absence, the Vice Chairman shall preside,
10	or in the absence of both, the Secretary shall preside.
11	6) Quorum and Meetings. A quorum of all
12	regular and special meetings and business of the Bcard
	shall be three members. Regular and special meetings
13	shall called by the Chairman on his own initiative or
15	be held at such time and in such place upon majority
16	votes of members of the Board.
17	7) Records of Meetings. The Secretary shall
18	keep full and accurate minutes of all meetings and
19	actions of the Board which shall be available for public
20	inspection upon permission by the Governor or the
21	Speaker."
22	Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect
23	upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law
24	without such approval.
