

AN ACT

To amend Section 52 of Chapter 3, Title 15 of the Truk State Code, as amended to provide for a member of the Committee on Education of the Truk State Legislature to serve on the State Scholarship Board, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State that:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 52 of Chapter 3 of Title
2 15 of the Truk State Code, as amended by TSL No. 5-96, is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 52. Scholarship Board.

5 1) Establishment. There is hereby established
6 a Truk State Scholarship Board, which shall have the
7 power to select qualified recipients to receive
8 grants under this act, and shall exercise such other
9 duties and powers as are provided by this act.

10 2) Composition. The Scholarship Board shall
11 be composed of five members, to be appointed as
12 follows:

13 a) Two members to be appointed by the
14 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Truk
15 State Legislature, or an appropriate committee
16 designated for that purpose; and

17 b) Three members to be appointed by the
18 Speaker, one of whom shall be a member of the
19 Committee on Education of the Truk State Legislature.

20 3) Terms of Office. The term of office for
21 members of the Scholarship Board shall be a period of
22 three years, from the date of appointment provided
23 that a vacancy on the Board shall be filled for the
24 unexpired term in the same manner as originally
25 filled.

26 4) Removal.

27 a) Members of the Board may be removed from
28 the Board for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeas-
29 ance in office, by a three-fourths votes of all members
30 of the Board.

2) The Governor and the Speaker shall also have the power to remove their respective appointed members of the Board for incompetence, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office.


5) Officers. The Board shall elect from among its members a Chairman, a Vice Chairman and a Secretary during its first meeting. The Chairman shall ordinarily preside at meetings of the Board, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman shall preside, or in the absence of both, the Secretary shall preside.

6) Quorum and Meetings. A quorum of all regular and special meetings and business of the Board shall be three members. Regular and special meetings shall be called by the Chairman on his own initiative or be held at such time and in such place upon majority votes of members of the Board.

7) Records of Meetings. The Secretary shall keep full and accurate minutes of all meetings and actions of the Board which shall be available for public inspection upon permission by the Governor or the Speaker."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
