SECOND REGULAR SESSION, MAY 1987

AN ACT

Establishing a Constitutional Convention for the State of Truk, prescribing its powers, duties and functions, authorizing appropriation thereof, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

- Section 1. Constitutional Convention. A Constitutional
- Convention is established for the purpose of drafting a Con-2
- stitution for the State of Truk. 3
- Section 2. Members of the Convention. Members shall be
- known as delegates. The Convention shall consist of 28 dele-5
- gates all of whom shall be residents of Truk and citizens of 6
- the Federated States of Micronesia. Each of the 13 Election
- Precincts, as designed in the State Charter, shall elect at a Я
- special or general election on the Second Tuesday of November, 9
- 1987, delegates in the numbers shown in Article IX of the Truk 1.0
- State Charter. 11
- Section 3. Vacancies. 12
- 1) As used in this Section, the term "Vacancy" includes 1.3
- a vacancy from death, resignation, and incapacity to serve as 14
- a delegate by reason of illness, upon finding of the same by 15
- the Convention. 16
- 2) A vacancy for any delegate shall be filled by the candi-17
- date receiving the next highest number of votes in the election. 1.8
- In the event that there is no alternative delegate, the Governor 19
- shall appoint a resident of the election precinct involved who 20
- has the qualifications of a delegate to fill the vacancy. 21
- Section 4. Session of the Convention. The Convention shall 22
- be convened at 9:30 a.m. on the First Monday in January 1988, 23
- and shall continue to be in session for a period of not more 24
- than a total of 60 meetings or working days. The Convention 25
- shall meet Monday through Friday except, holidays, PROVIDED, 26
- that the Convention sessions may be held on weekend or holidays, 27
- or the Convention may recess for a period not to exceed a total 28
- of 30 days by a majority vote of the Convention delegates. 29

Section 5. Progedure.

Into Convention shall convene on Moen at a location to be selected by the Pre-Convention Committee.

- 2) The Chairman of the Pre-Convention Committee or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, shall act as President of the Convention until the Convention shall elect a President from among its members.
- 3) The Convention shall elect, from among its members, a
 9 President, a Vice-President, and a Floor Leader, and such addi10 tional officers as it may deem necessary and appropriate.
- 11 4) The following committees are established to carry out the duties of the Convention:
- 13 a) Committee on Executive;
- b) Committee on Legislative;
- 15 c) Committee on Judiciary;
- d) Committee on Other Provisions; and
- e) Committee on Style and Arrangement.
- 18 5) Other Committees may be established by the Convention 19 as it deems appropriate. The Committee on Style and Arrangement 20 shall provide the necessary translation of the new Draft
- 22 6) The Convention shall adopt its own Rules of Procedure
 23 not inconsistent with this Act; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no
 24 constitutional provisions may be finally adopted by the Convention
 25 except by the affirmative votes of not less than 3/4 of the
 26 delegates present, a quorum being present, and that no voting
 27 except in person shall be permitted, and that abstensions
- 28 shall not be counted as affirmative votes in determining the
- 29 result of any vote by the Convention to finally adopt a consti-
- 30 tutional provision.

- 31 7) A quorum shall consist of 2/3 of all the delegates.
- Section 6. <u>Investigative Powers</u>. The Convention and its committees and subcommittees shall be investigating committees as defined in Truk State Law 27-37, and shall have all the powers

15 and authorities with all the appropriate penalties which may

be given to investigating committees as set forth in Truk State Law No.27-37.

Section 7. Duties. The Convention shall draft a Constitution for the State of Truk. The Constitution shall contain provisions for the exercise of Legislative, Executive and Judicial functions, for the guarantee of individual rights, for establishment of a government that directly expresses the wishes of the people of Truk. The Convention may use the Draft Constitution of Truk and the Truk State Charter, both English and Trukese versions, as reference and informational materials for its work. It shall provide in the Draft Constitution an effective date, and shall require approval by popular referendum as specified in this Act. The Convention shall transmit a certified copy of the adopted and signed Constitution and Convention Journal to the Governor and Speaker of the Legislature. Upon receipt of the Constitution, the Governor shall call a referendum on the Constitution subject to the provisions of Section 12 of this Act.

Section 8. Support.

- 1) The officers and employees of the Truk State Government at all levels shall cooperate with the Convention by furnishing such information and assistance as may be called for in connection with the research activities of the Convention and any other work of the Convention.
- 2) The State Government shall provide such administrative secretarial, technical and staff assistance to the Convention as may be deemed necessary by the Convention.
- 3) The Governor shall provide every assistance required to enable the smooth opening of the Convention as provided for in Section 4 and 5 of this Act, including its future sessions until the work of the Convention is completed.
- Section 9. <u>Administrative Leave</u>. Officials and employees of the State Government who are delegates to the Convention shall be granted administrative leave with pay.

Section 10. Salaries and Expenses of Delegates.

               1) The Governor shall, by proclamation, set a date for

      receipt by the Governor of a copy of the adopted and signed Constitution

                Section 13. Pre-Convention Committee. There shall be
 35
       a Pre-Convention Committee which shall consist of five delegates,

two of whom shall be chosen by the Governor, two by the Speaker of the Truk State Legislature and one by the Chief Justice of the Truk State Court from among the 28 delegates elected under Section 2 of this Act; PROVIDED, that the five delegates so chosen shall each represent one of the five Congressional Election Precincts. 5 The Committee shall hold its first meeting on a day and at a place to be designated in writing by the oldest member and such other meetings 20 days prior to the first meeting day of the Convention. During the first meeting, the Committee shall elect its Chairman, Vice-Chairman and a Secretary. Also during the first and subsequent 10 meetings, the Committee shall: 12 a) draft proposed rules of procedure for adoption by the 13 Convention; 14 b) facilitate the work for the Convention by ensuring that accomodations and facilities for the Convention are in prior order; 15 16 and 17 c) take such reasonable and appropriate actions to accomplish 18 the above duties and the purpose of the Convention. . :9 Section 14. Effective Date of the Constitution. The effective **2**0 date of the Constitution shall be so fixed as to permit the current Legislature and Administration to serve out their full 4-year 22 terms. 13 Section 15. Appropriation Authorization. There is hereby 24 authorized to be appropriated from the General Fund of the State Ĵ5 such sum and at such time as may be necessary for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act relating to the expenses and operation of the Constitutional Convention.
