AN ACT

To prohibit all State employees in the public service from receiving compensation from more than one public source at the same time, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

    cases state employees in the public service receive compensation
    for their state employment and at the same time also receive com-
   pensation for another government (State, National, or Municipal)
   position. Given the high rate of unemployment in the state and
    in consideration of ensuring that state employees completely ful-
    fill their primary state duties, state employees should receive
    only their salary, wage, or compensation from their state employ-

         Section 2. State employees To Receive Compensation From Only
    One Public Source. State employees in the public service shall be
   eligible to receive only their salary, wage, or compensation from
