

AN ACT

To prohibit all State employees in the public service from receiving compensation from more than one public source at the same time, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

Section 1. Findings. The Legislature finds that in many cases state employees in the public service receive compensation for their state employment and at the same time also receive compensation for another government (State, National, or Municipal) position. Given the high rate of unemployment in the state and in consideration of ensuring that state employees completely fulfill their primary state duties, state employees should receive only their salary, wage, or compensation from their state employment.

10 Section 2. State employees To Receive Compensation From Only
11 One Public Source. State employees in the public service shall be
12 eligible to receive only their salary, wage, or compensation from
13 their state employment and shall be ineligible to receive any form
14 of compensation from any other state, national, or municipal employ-
15 ment. It shall be grounds for immediate termination from state
16 employment for state employees to receive compensation from another
17 public source, while receiving state compensation for employment in
18 the public service.

19 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon
20 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such
21 approval.
