AN ACT

To create the Truk Visitors Bureau, and to provide for its organization, terms of office, powers and duties, to provide the source of funds for its initial operation, to repeal TSL No. 22-20, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

- Section 1. Findings and Declaration of Policy. The Truk State Legis-
- 2 lature finds that tourism is an important developing industry, and has great
- 3 potential as a source of business and employment opportunities for the resi-
- dents of the State of Truk. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the
- 5 Truk State Government that the development of the tourist industry will be
- 6 encouraged and in order to provide for the orderly development of this indus-
- 7 try and to realize its full potential, it is necessary to utilize Truk's
- 8 tourist oriented business, government and community leaders in a concerted
- 9 and unified manner.
- 10 Section 2. Creation. The Truk Visitors Bureau, hereinafter referred
- 11 to as the "Visitors Bureau", is hereby created.
- Section 3. Governing Body. The Visitors Bureau shall be governed by
- a Board of Directors, to be composed of nine (9) members, five (5) of whom
- shall be appointed by the Governor of Truk State with the advice and consent
- of the Truk State Legislature, and four (4) of whom shall be appointed by the
- Speaker of the Truk State Legislature. Of the nine (9) members appointed by
- 17 the Governor and the Speaker, five (5) shall be from the private sector-tourist
- oriented businesses and four (4) shall be selected from among the people of
- 19 Truk State. The Director of the State Department of Resources and Development
- 20 shall be the technical staff of the Board until the Executive Director of the
- 21 Bureau is appointed by the Board.
- 22 Section 4. Term of Office. Term of office for all members of the Board o.
- 23 Directors shall be two (2) years. Vacancies on the Board due to illness,
- death or resignation shall be filled in the same manner as initially filled,
- and shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of the affected member.
- 26. Any member may be removed from the Board for good cause, as determined by the
- 27 affirmative votes of five (1) members of the Board, taken during a quorumed
- .) meeting of the Board.

Section 5. Compensation of Board Members. All members of the Board 1 of Directors of the Visitors Bureau shall be entitled to compensation, or 2 allowance in lieu of compensation, as provided by law for boards and commis-3 sions, when actually performing their official duties as members of the 4 Board at the direction of the Board; PROVIDED, that those members who are 5 employees of the national and state governments and who attend meetings of 6 the Board during their government regular working hours shall not be entitled 7 to compensation or allowance other than their respective government salary. 8 Section 6. Organization Meeting. Within thirty (30) days after the 9 confirmation of the members of the Board, the State Director of the Depart-10 ment of Resources and Development shall call the first meeting of the Board 11 and preside over that meeting. At the first meeting, the Board shall elect 12 from among its members a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer and a Secretary. 13 The Board may also elect other officers as it shall deem necessary. The 14 Board shall meet at least once every quarter at a time and place to be de-15 termined by the Chairman. The Chairman may also call additional meetings 16 of the Board as he shall deem necessary, or upon the petition of five (5) 17 members of the Board. 18 Section 7. Quorum. Six (6) members of the Board shall constitute 19 a quorum of the meetings of the Board, and the concurrence of the majority 20 of the members of the Board shall be necessary for official action of the 21 Board; provided, a quorum is present during the taking of such action. The 22 Chairman of the Board shall be the Executive representative of the Bureau and 23 its certifying officer. 24 Section 8. Executive Director. The day to day activities of the 25 Bureau shall be supervised and managed by an Executive Director, who shall 26 be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board. The Board shall 27 provide such staff and clerical employees as it deems necessary, subject to 28 the limitations imposed by law and availability of funds, to assist the 29 Executive Director in carrying out the functions of the Bureau. 30 Section 9. Powers and Duties of the Bureau. The Bureau small, through 31 the Board of Directors, have the following powers and duties: 32 (1) to actract tentiate to the islands of Trik Stitu; 33 (2) to conduct programs of advertising confidence and promotion

designed to familiarize the travelling public with Truk's diving wrecks, historic significance, sport fishing, cultural and other 2 attractions and increase the number of visitors to Truk; 3 (3) to advise the Governor and the Truk State Legislature on the need for expansion and improvement of existing tourist facilities and 5 recommend steps to provide an increasing degree of visitor satisfaction after arrival; (4) to encourage the investment of private funds for expansion 8 and improvement of tourist facilities in Truk; 9 (5) to operate the Truk Ethnographic Exhibition and to establish 10 reception and information booths and other facilities and provide 11 staff for the same to operate on arrival of tourists; 12 (6) to promote island-wide clean-up, planting and beautification 13 14 programs; (7) to prepare information booklets in English, Japanese and 15 other appropriate languages, for distribution to all incoming visitors; 16 (8) to study and survey tourist needs and facilities; 17 (9) to recommend and request acquisition of sites suitable 18 for tourist facilities; 19 (10) to cooperate with public and private groups and 20 organizations; 21 (11) to coordinate its efforts with departments and agencies 22 of the State and municipal Governments; 23 (12) to employ technical services and any other staff as it 24 may require to effectively promote the functions of the Bureau; 25 (13) to obtain membership in any regional or international 26 tourist organization which will effectively promote the functions 27 of the Bureau; 28 (14) to adopt, with the approval of the Governor, such rules 29 and regulations as may be necessary to implement the provisions of 30 this act; and 31 (15) to compile such statistics as may be helpful to carry out 3.2 the purpose of this 101.

1	Section 10. Accounts and Records. The Truk Visitors Bureau shall keep
2	such accounts and records as may be necessary to enable the Truk State Legis-
3	lature to determine whether the provisions of this act are being complied with.
4	Such accounts shall at all times be available for inspection and audit, as may
5	be determined by the Truk State Legislature.
6	Section 11. Annual Report. The Truk Visitors Bureau shall make an
7	annual report to the Governor and the Truk State Legislature at the close of
8	each fiscal year, which shall set forth a summation of its activities, balance
9	sheets showing all assets, liabilities, and fund equity, and a statement of
10	revenues, expenditures and changes in fund balance, and its recommendations
11	for improvement.
12	Section 12. Transfer of Property to the Visitors Bureau. Upon the
13	effective date of this act, the following properties shall be transferred to
14	the Visitors Bureau:
15	(1) all supplies, records, statistics, brochures, maps and other
16	items related to tourism which are owned by the Department of Resources
17	and Development of the State of Truk; and
18	(2) all historic artifacts, handicrafts, photographs, displays
19	and other items at the Truk Ethnographic Exhibition Center which are
20	owned by the State Department of Resources and Development.
21	Section 13. Repeal Truk State Law No. 22-20, creating the Tourist
22	Commission, as amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
23	Section 14. Initial Funding. The sum of \$15,000 as appropriated by
24	Section 5(a)(24) of Truk State Law No. 6-24, for Visitors Bureau, shall be
25	the source of funding for the initial operation of the Truk Visitors Bureau.

	Section 15. Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon approval
	by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
