

AN ACT

To amend Section 4 and Section 13 of Truk State Law No. 6-16, as amended by Truk State Law No. 6-23 and Truk State Law No. 6-25, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 4 of Truk State Law No. 6-16, as amended by Truk State Law No. 6-23 and Truk State Law No. 6-25, is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"Section 4. Session of the Convention. The Convention shall be convened at 9:30 a.m., on the second Monday after adjournment sine die of the Third Regular Session of the Third Truk State Legislature, and shall continue to be in session for a period of not more than a total of 60 meeting or working days. The Convention shall meet Monday through Friday, except holidays; PROVIDED, that the Convention sessions may be held on weekend or holidays, or the Convention may recess for a period of not to exceed a total of 15 days by a majority vote of the Convention delegates."

Section 2. Amendment. Section 13 of Truk State Law No. 6-16 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 13. Pre-Convention Committee. There shall be a Pre-Convention Committee which shall consist of five delegates, two of whom shall be chosen by the Governor, two by the Speaker of the Truk State Legislature and one by the Chief Justice of the Truk State Court from among the 28 delegates elected under Section 2 of this Act; PROVIDED, that the five delegates so chosen shall each represent one of the five Congressional Election Precincts. The Committee shall hold its first meeting on a day and at a place to be designated in writing by the oldest member and such other meetings prior to the first meeting day of the Convention. During the first meeting, the Committee shall elect its Chairman, Vice-Chairman and a Secretary. Also during the first and subsequent meetings, the Committee shall:

- 1 a) draft proposed rules and procedures for adoption by the Conven-
- 2 tion;
- 3 b) facilitate the work for the Convention by ensuring that accommo-
- 4 dations and facilities for the Convention are in proper order; and
- 5 c) take such reasonable and appropriate actions to accomplish
- 6 the above duties and the purpose of the Convention."

7 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon approval
8 by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
