

## AN ACT

To amend Truk State Law No. 6-16, as amended, by enabling the Truk State 1988 Constitutional Convention to create and organize its own committees, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

Section 1. Amendment. Section 5(4) of Truk State Law No. 6-16, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Procedure.

1) The Convention shall convene on Moen at a location to be selected by the Pre-Convention Committee.

2) The Chairman of the Pre-Convention Committee or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, shall act as President of the Convention until the Convention shall elect a President from among its members.


3) The Convention shall elect, from among its members, a President, a Vice-President, and a Floor Leader, and such additional officers as it may deem necessary and appropriate.


4) The Convention shall have the authority to create its own committees and sub-committees through its Rules of Procedure with the necessary powers including those provided under Section 6 hereof.

5) The Convention shall adopt its own Rules of Procedure not inconsistent with this Act; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that no constitutional provisions may be finally adopted by the Convention except by the affirmative votes of not less than 3/4 of the delegates present, a quorum being present, and that no voting except in person shall be permitted, and that abstentions shall not be counted as affirmative votes in determining the result of any vote by the Convention to finally adopt a constitutional provision.


6) A quorum shall consist of 2/3 of all the delegates."

1 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon  
2 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
