

AN ACT

To amend Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 6-14, as amended by Truk State Law No. 6-29, to reprogram funds authorized for Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Ninth Election Districts, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 1 of Truk State Law No. 6-14, as amended by Truk State Law No. 6-29, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the State for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1987, for the purpose of funding municipal projects, programs and operations, pursuant to Truk State Law No. 3-6, to be allocated as follows:
