

AN ACT

To amend Sections 5, 7 and 10 of Truk State Law No. 6-24, relating to the Operating Expenses of Other Programs, the Operating Expenses of CIP/Economic Projects, the Allotment and Management of Funds and their lapsing dates, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State.

1 Section 1. Amendment. Section 5 of Truk State Law No. 6-24, is hereby
2 amended, to read as follows:

3 "Section 5(a). Operating Expenses of Other Programs. The sum of
4 \$3,108,256 (\$1,599,985-Current Account; \$1,423,370-Local Revenue; \$84,901-
5 Reimbursement), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
6 from the General Fund of the State for the fiscal year 1988, for the purpose
7 of funding the Operations of Other Programs of the State. All funds
8 appropriated by this Section shall remain available until fully expended.
9 The Governor shall be the allottee of such funds except for funds for
10 Housing Authority, Maritime Authority and Development Authorities in which
11 the allottee shall be the Board for each Authority, and these funds shall
12 apportioned as follows:

12 (b) Division of Municipal Operation Fund. The funds appropriated
 13 for the municipalities in each of the thirteen election districts by this
 14 Section shall be allocated to the municipalities in accordance with the formula
 15 as established by Truk State Law No. 3-6 for Precinct Allocation.

16 (c) The use of the funds allocated to each of the thirteen election
 17 districts pursuant to this formula shall be determined by the municipal council
 18 and reflected in a municipal ordinance enacted thereto.

19 (d) The funds appropriated shall be allocated to each election district
 20 as follows:

1 (e) All Development Authorities, Programs and other agencies which
2 are Legislature's creations and funded by revenues generated by tax laws of
3 the State of Truk shall submit to the Legislature their annual reports within
4 the first fifteen days of the Legislature's regular session on the use and
5 operations of their respective offices. Failure to do so as required by law
6 shall be cause for immediate discontinuance of their funds in the succeeding
7 year."

8 Section 2. Section 7 of Truk State Law No. 6-24, is hereby amended to
9 read as follows:

10 "Section 7. Operating Expenses of CIP/Economic Development Projects.
11 The sum of \$10,314,912 (\$10,314,912 Section 211), or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State for the
13 purpose of funding the operations of the CIP/Economic Development Projects
14 of the State. These funds shall remain available until fully expended. The
15 Governor shall be the allottee of such funds, and those funds shall be
16 apportioned as follows:

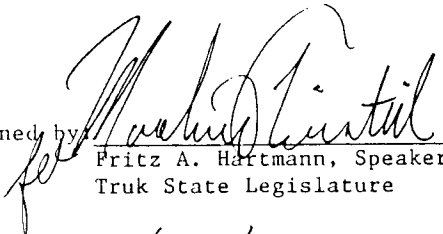
16 Funds. The funds appropriated for Municipal Social & Economic Development
 17 Projects by this Section shall be allocated to the municipalities in
 18 accordance with the formula provided on pages 186, 187 and 188 of the Truk
 19 State Official Five Year Over-All Economic Development Plan."

20 Section 3. Section 10 of Truk State Law No. 6-24, is hereby amended, to
 21 read as follows:

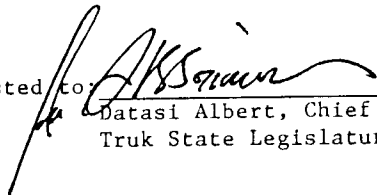
22 "Section 10. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapsing Date.
 23 All funds appropriated by this Act shall be allotted, managed, administered
 24 and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including the State
 25 Financial Management Act. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring
 26 that these funds are used only for the purposes specified in this Act, and that
 27 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated. The authority
 28 of the allottee to obligate the funds appropriated for the operations of the
 29 CIP/Economic Development Projects of the State shall continue until these
 30 funds are fully expended."

1 Section 4. This Act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor,
2 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
