

AN ACT

To amend Truk State Law No. 5-86 as it relates to the qualifications for persons employed as an attorney for the Truk State Legislature, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Truk State:

1 Section 1. Amendment. Truk State Law No. 5-86 is hereby
2 amended by amending Section 1, to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Any person employed as an attorney
4 for the Truk State Legislature shall be a graduate of an
5 accredited law school and admitted to practice law in any
6 jurisdiction, including but not limited to the Federated
7 States of Micronesia Bar. Any person employed as an
8 attorney for the Truk State Legislature and who is not a
9 member of the FSM Bar shall have one year from his or her
10 first day of employment to become admitted to the FSM Bar.
11 Failure to gain admission to the FSM Bar within the
12 required one year period shall be good cause for termina-
13 tion from their employment."

14 Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon
15 approval by the Governor, or upon its becoming law without such
16 approval.
