PUBLIC LAW NO. 22-61

AN ACT

To amend section 145 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, by expanding the applicability of maternity leave to all national government employees and fixing it at 8 consecutive weeks, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 145 of title 52 of the Code of the 1
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, is hereby
- amended to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 145. Leaves of absence.
- 5 (1) Leaves of absence with pay may be granted to
- employees by management officials for reasons of 6
- vacation, illness, training, or education, or for 7
- such other reason as will be in the best interests of 8
- 9 the public service. Eligibility for such leaves, the
- 10 method and rate of earning such eligibility, and the
- 11 duration of the leave shall be established by
- 12 regulations.
- 13 (2) Leave of absence without pay may be granted for
- 14 such reasons as management officials may deem proper
- 15 and consistent with the best interests of the public
- 16 service. Regulations may prescribe the
- characteristics of such leaves. 17
- (3) Paid maternity leave of absence shall be 18

1	granted to an employee for a period of eight
2	consecutive weeks per twelve month period:
3	(a) For purposes of this section, "maternity
4	leave" means leave in connection with the birth of a
5	child of the employee. Maternity leave applies to all
6	national employees, regardless of employment status,
7	whether permanent or probationary status, and whether
8	a public service or exempt employee.
9	(b) Paid maternity leave shall not be
10	considered to be annual leave or sick leave accrued
11	in a calendar year.
12	(c) Paid maternity leave shall not accumulate
13	for any subsequent use if not used by an employee
14	before the end of each calendar year.
15	(d) The employer through its management
16	officials may require the employee to provide a
17	doctor's certificate indicating general condition
18	during pregnancy and the expected delivery date."
