A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$10,177,824 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$1,969,570 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$926,259 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$183,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

Section 1. Appropriation. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$5,889,421, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$896,666, or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$881,352, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013.
