





A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,738,752 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$1,934,122 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,017,707 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$183,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Appropriation. Operation of the Executive. The sum of ~~\$6,087,079~~, or so
2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of
3 \$878,829, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund;
4 the sum of \$960,639 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United
5 States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2014.

10 (1) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 1 and 11 of this act is the
11 Governor.

12 (2) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 3 of this act is the Speaker of
13 the Kosrae State Legislature.

14 (3) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 5 of this act is the Chief
15 Justice of the Kosrae State Court.

16 (4) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 7 of this act is the Public
17 Auditor.

18 (5) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
19 subsection (1) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority.

20 (6) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
21 subsection (2) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Island Resource

1 Management Authority.

2 (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
3 subsection (3) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Parole Board.

4 (8) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
5 subsection (4) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae State Scholarship Board.

6 (9) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
7 subsection (5) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae
8 Visitors Bureau.

9 (10) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
10 subsection (6) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.

11 Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is not allowed where the use of the
12 reprogrammed funds would be: inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of
13 funds specified in the Amended Compact of Free Association and its related agreements.
14 Reprogramming is not allowed where the use of reprogrammed funds would be used for
15 activities not specified and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation the following is
16 allowed:

17 (1) The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
18 apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other
19 numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act. The Governor or is designee may reprogram up to
20 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered subsection of
21 Section 2 of this act to or from any other lettered object class within that same numbered

1 subsection. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
2 apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 12 of this act to or from any other numbered
3 subsections of Section 12 of this act.

4 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
5 apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 4 of this act to or from any other lettered
6 object class within Section 4.

7 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total
8 amount apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 6 of this act to or from any other
9 lettered object class within Section 6.

10 (4) The Public Auditor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total
11 amount apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 8 of this act to or from any other
12 lettered object class within Section 8.

13 (5) Each allottee identified in number subsections of Section 10 of this act or his
14 designee, may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class
15 of the numbered subsection of Section 10 for which he/she is the allottee, either to or from any
16 other lettered object class of the same numbered subsection.

17 (6) Notwithstanding, Sections (1), (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 14,
18 reprogramming of funds into or from personnel budget line item shall not be permitted.
