Dear Speaker Abraham:

I am pleased to inform you that I have signed into law Legislative Bill No. 10-22, L.D. ⁶, which will become State Law No. 10-14, entitled:

“To appropriate the sum of \$10,178,259 from the Amended Compact Fund, the sum of \$1,936,766 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,019,393 from the United State Grant Fund; The sum of \$183,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies and various programs, and infrastructure development projects; and for other purposes.”

As noted on the attached Legislative Bill No. 10-22, L.D. ⁶, which becomes State Law No. 10-14, I veto two line items as listed below:

- Page 7 of 15 line 1 (\$25,600, reduced it to \$20,000)
- Page 11 of 15 line 2 (\$40,000, reduced it to \$0)
- The total amount for the local revenue will be amended to \$1,936,766.
- For the Amended Compact Fund, I hope that we amend the bill next session to reflect the appropriate amounts given the discrepancies shown in the bill.



I thank you and members of the Legislature for the hard work you've put into finalizing this legislation.



A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,388,320 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of ~~\$1,982,366~~^{1,936,766} from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$2,369,264 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$183,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Appropriation. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$4,532,574, or so
2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of
3 \$855,106, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund;
4 the sum of \$2,369,264, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United
5 States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

8 Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by
9 Section 1 of this act are apportioned as follows:

4 Section 13. Allottees.

5 (1) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 1 and 11 of this act is the
6 Governor.

7 (2) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 3 of this act is the Speaker of
8 the Kosrae State Legislature.

9 (3) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 5 of this act is the Chief
10 Justice of the Kosrae State Court.

11 (4) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 7 of this act is the Public
12 Auditor.

13 (5) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
14 subsection (1) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority.

15 (6) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
16 subsection (2) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Island Resource
17 Management Authority.

18 (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
19 subsection (3) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Parole Board.

20 (8) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
21 subsection (4) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae State Scholarship Board.

1 (9) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
2 subsection (5) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae
3 Visitors Bureau.

4 (10) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under
5 subsection (6) of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.

6 Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is not allowed where the use of the
7 reprogrammed funds would be: inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of
8 funds specified in the Amended Compact of Free Association and its related agreements.
9 Reprogramming is not allowed where the use of reprogrammed funds would be used for
10 activities not specified and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation the following is
11 allowed:

12 (1) The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
13 apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other
14 numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to
15 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered subsection of
16 Section 2 of this act to or from any other lettered object class within that same numbered
17 subsection. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
18 apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 12 of this act to or from any other numbered
19 subsections of Section 12 of this act.

20 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
21 apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 4 of this act to or from any other lettered

1 object class within Section 4.

2 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total
3 amount apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 6 of this act to or from any other
4 lettered object class within Section 6.

5 (4) The Public Auditor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total
6 amount apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 8 of this act to or from any other
7 lettered object class within Section 8.

8 (5) Each allottee identified in number subsections of Section 10 of this act, or his
9 designee, may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class
10 of the numbered subsection of Section 10 for which he/she is the allottee, either to or from any
11 other lettered object class of the same numbered subsection.



12 positions filled by contract for a term of one year or more. No funds appropriated by this act
13 may be allotted, obligated or expended to pay salary or benefits for a position, which is not
14 established under this act and filled in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

15 Section 16. Reversion. Any portion of the sums appropriated by this act not obligated
16 by September 30, 2012 reverts to the Fund from which appropriated, with the exception of funds
17 appropriated under Section 11 of this act. Funds appropriated under Section 11 of this act shall
18 not lapse.


19 Section 17. Effective Date. This act shall become effective upon the approval of the
20 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
