This is to inform you of the Legislature's further actions on L.B. No. 11-169, L.D.5. The Legislature reconsidered and re-passed the following vetoed line item over your objections:

1. Page 1 of 15, line 13, \$9,448 for Contractual under Revenue Fund source remains;
2. Page 8 of 15, line 3, \$50,069 for Travel under Revenue Fund source remains;
3. Page 8 of 15, line 4, \$33,000 for Contractual under Revenue Fund source remains;
4. Page 8 of 15, line 16, \$29,431 for Contractual under Revenue Fund source remains;
5. Page 8 of 15, line 17, \$51,500 for Others under Revenue Fund source remains.

Furthermore, the Legislature amends the following line items to meet your objections.

1. Page 5 of 15, line 5, \$116,021 for Contractual under Amended Compact Fund amended to \$113,021;
2. Page 5 of 15, line 13, \$31,300 for Others under Amended Compact Fund amended to \$28,800;
3. Page 7 of 15, line 12, \$196,584 for Personnel under Amended Compact Fund amended to \$195,687;
4. Page 7 of 15, line 13, \$59,500 for Travel under Amended Compact Fund amended to \$45,000;
5. Page 7 of 15, line 14, \$36,100 for Contractual under Amended Compact Fund amended to \$35,100.



A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$10,447,942 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$1,988,557 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$970,773 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$55,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1 Section 1. Appropriations. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$6,552,936 or so much
2 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$884,316 , or
3 so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$952,168
4 , or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum
5 of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for
6 the operation of the Executive Branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018.

7 Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by Section 1 of this
8 act are apportioned as follows:

- 20 (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (5) of Section
21 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Scholarship Board.

1 (8) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (6) of Section
2 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae Visitors Bureau.

3 (9) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (7) of Section
4 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.

5 Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is now allowed where the use of the reprogrammed
6 funds would be inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of funds in the Amended
7 Compact of Free Association and its related agreements or reprogrammed funds would be used for
8 activities not specified and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation the following is allowed:

9 (1) The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned
10 to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other numbered subsection of
11 Section 2 of this act. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
12 apportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act to or from
13 any other lettered object class within that same numbered subsection. The Governor or his designee may
14 reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 12 of this
15 act to or from any other numbered subsections of Section 12 of this act.

16 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned to
17 any lettered object class within Section 4 of this act to or from any other lettered object class within
18 Section 4.

1 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
2 apporportioned to any lettered object class within Section 6 of this act to or from any other lettered object
3 class within Section 6.

4 (4) The Public Auditor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount
5 apporportioned to any lettered object class within Section 8 of this act to or from any other lettered object
6 class within Section 8.

7 (5) Each allottee identified in numbered subsections of Section 10 of this act, or his designee,
8 may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apporportioned to any lettered object class of the numbered
9 subsection of Section 10 for which he/she is the allottee, either to or from any other lettered object class
10 of the same numbered subsection.
