A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Title 19 at Chapter 8, by adding a new Section 19.826 of the Kosrae State Code, to establish the Mahkontowe Conservation Area under the Protected Areas Act of 2010; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1	Section 1. <u>Purpose</u> . The Mahkontowe Conservation Area is to demonstrate the						
2	ancient historical, cultural, social and agricultural and natural environmental significance						
3	of the Mahkohntowe, the Kosrae's Sleeping Lady, for three purposes: (1) to create the						
4	Mahkontowe Conservation Area under the Protected Areas Act of 2010, supported by						
5	Title 19 of the Kosrae State Code for the purpose of preserving Kosrae natural						
6	environment and culture, (2) to boost the economy of the State in an historic manner						
7	with an eco-tourism site and variety of activities; and (3) to create job and facilities						
8	opportunities for self-employment.						
9	Section 2. Amendment. Title 19 of the Kosrae State Code is hereby amended						
10	by adding a new Section 19.826 to read s follows:						
11	"Section 19.826. Establishment of the Mahkontowe Conservation Area.						
12	(1) It is hereby, established the terrestrial protected area known as the						
13	Mahkohntowe Conservation Area which shall be subject to the provision						
14	of the Protected Areas Act of 2010 and be administered by the Kosrae						
15	Island Resource Management Authority (KIRMA).						
16	(2) The Goals of the Mahkontowe Conservation Areas are to (1) preserve						
¥	Kosrae's natural and cultural resources and culture by protecting and						
	prohibiting any human activities particularly economic development,						

1		harves	sting of natural resources and collection, displacement, and
2		destru	ction of cultural sites and artifacts within the core and buffer zones,
3		(2)	to boost the economy of the State with eco-tourism activities
4			supporting creation of jobs and other opportunities.
5	(3)	The M	Sahkontowe Conservation Area is located within the interior
6		terrest	rial areas of Kosrae, with a total area of 15 square kilometers
7		consis	sting of Zones namely; the Core, Buffer, and Transition.
8	(4)	The M	Sahkontowe Conservation Area shall comprise of the Core and
9		Buffe	Zones as prescribed for protection and prohibiting of human
10		activit	ties relating to any economic development, harvesting, and
11		exploi	tation of biodiversity and natural resources, collection, displacement
12		and de	estruction of cultural sites and artifacts.
13	(5)	The M	Mahkontowe Conservation Area Core Zone:
14		(i)	The Core Zone has an area of 1,371.73 hectares (13.7 sq km) and
15			is centrally located among the other zones. The Core Zone shall be
16			a no take and development zone, meaning all economic
17			development and natural resources and biodiversity extractive
18			activities are prohibited. The Core Zone is larger than the rest of
19			the zones, which should not subtract from the level of protection
20			and enforcement it shall receive. The Core Area is subject to
21		19	current Kosrae State law regarding protected and endangered
22			species.

1		(ii)	The Core Zone boundaries shall be established through
2			regulations by KIRMA.
3	(6)	The M	ahkontowe Conservation Areas Buffer Zone:
4		(i)	The Buffer Zone begins at the boundary of the Core Zone and
5			extends 50 meters beyond the Core Zone. It has an area of 86.9
6			hectares (0.86 sq. km) and adjoins the Core Zone and Transitional
7			Zone. It is the second smallest portion of the Mahkontowe
8			Conservation Area and forms the perimeter around the Core Zone
9			and also spreads out from the Core Zone by 50 meters. The Buffer
10			Zone is to insulate the Core Zone from human activities and
11			developmental pressures most likely to occur in the Transition
12			Zone.
13		(ii)	The boundaries of Buffer Zone shall be established by regulation
14			by KIRMA.
15	(7)	The M	ahkontowe Conservation Area Transition Zone:
16		(i)	The Transition Zone begins at the end of the Buffer Zone and
17			extends a distance of 25 meters away from the Buffer Zone. It has
18			an area of 44.18 hectares (0.44 sq. km) and adjoins the Buffer
19			Zone. It forms the perimeter around the Buffer Zone and takes up
19			the smallest area of the entire Mahkontowe Conservation Area.
20			The Transition Zone is a flexible area which can contain
21			agricultural activities, settlements, and other uses related to the

1		conservation, management, and visitation to the Mahkontowe			
2		Conservation Area. Commencement of new construction of			
3		Mahkontowe Area requires contractors to have a Kosrae			
4		Development Permit and to abide by the Kosrae State			
5		Environmental Impact Assessments guidelines and the Kosrae			
6		State Land Use Plan.			
7	(ii)	The boundaries of the Transition Zone shall be established by			
8		regulation by KIRMA.			
9	Section 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon the approval of the				
10	Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
