#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend State Law No. 11-116, by amending certain sections of Title 11, Chapter 19 to identify plastic grocery bags and include it accordingly; and for other purposes.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1	Section 1. <u>Purpose</u> . Plastic grocery bags are often discarded into the environment
2	after use, causing detrimental impact both aesthetically and ecologically on Kosrae's
3	marine and terrestrial environment. Plastic grocery bags are responsible for the death of
4	many fish, turtles, dolphins and other marine and terrestrial animals that are essential to
5	the food security and ecology of Kosrae. These animals mistake plastic grocery bags for
6	jellyfish and other food sources. Plastic grocery bags take approximately 20 years to
7	break down once they are discarded on land and in the ocean. They do not dissolve; they
8	break down into smaller pieces allowing all levels of the food chain to be harmed. Plastic
9	pollution in oceans is an enormous problem globally, and plastic grocery bags are
10	significant part of this problem. Because of their wind borne nature, even plastic bags
11	that are disposed of responsibly are often carried by the wind reducing the beauty of
12	our natural landscape and ultimately ending up in our oceans. Purpose of these proposed
13	amendments is to restrict the sale and use of Plastic grocery bags in the State of Kosrae,
14	FSM.
15	Section 2. Amendments. Title 11, Section 11.1902 of the Kosrae State Code is
16	hereby amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 11.1902. <u>Definition</u> . Except as provided in Section 11.1904 of
18	this chapter:

1	"plasti	c bags" means a shopping or grocery carryout bags that hash handles,	
2	made from (in whole, or in part) polyethylene and is either biodegradable or		
3	non-bi	odegradable provided by a wholesale business or retailer, including shops,	
4	restaur	ants and salespeople to a customer at the point of sale and incidental to the	
5	purcha	se of other goods.	
6	Section	n 11.1903. Prohibition regarding Plastic grocery bags.	
7	(1)	Except as provided in Section11.194 of this Chapter, no person selling or	
8		distributing any merchandise within the State, whether wholesale or retail,	
9		shall offer or provided any form of plastic grocery bag to hold or contain	
10		such merchandise for the convenience of the customer.	
11	(2)	Any person who violates this section shall be fined not more than \$100 for	
12		each offense.	
13	Section	n 11.1904. Exception. The ban on plastic bag imposed by Section 11.1903	
14	shall n	ot apply to:	
15	(1)	The original plastic packaging materials in which the merchandise is	
16		enclosed and sealed upon manufacture, fabrication or preparation. Original	
17		plastic packaging that constitutes, or forms an integral part of, the	
18		packaging in which goods are sealed prior to sale; and	
19	(2)	Plastic Bags used exclusively to carry chilled or frozen merchandise sold	
20		by the merchant, such as refrigerated meats and vegetables and freezer ice	
21		cream and ice cubes, irrespective of whether individual chilled or	
22		commodity are also originally packaged in plastic as described in

1		Subsection (1) of this section.
2	(3)	Bags or baskets made entirely or paper or local plant materials; and
3	(4)	Reusable bags that are specifically designed and manufactured for
4		multiple reuse over a period of at least two years and are made of durable
5		material suitable for reuse; and
6	(5)	Single use, fresh produce bags without handles (barrier or roll bags) when
7		used for otherwise unpackaged fresh produce including meat, fish, fruits,
8		and vegetables; and
9	(6)	Freezer bags or snap lock bags designed for food storage, when distributed
10		in their original packaging and not distributed individually to consumers
11		for otherwise unpackaged produce including meat, fish, fruits and
12		vegetables; and
13	(7)	Garbage bin liners or garbage bags, when distributed in their original
14		packaging and not distributed individually to consumers."
15	Section	n 11.1905. Rules and Regulations. KIRMA shall make, promulgate and
16	amend such r	ules and regulations necessary to implement and enforce this Chapter. All
17	such rules and	d regulations upon approval of the Governor, shall have the force and effect
18	of law.	
19	Section	n 11.1906. Enforcement. Enforcement of this Chapter shall take effect six
20	months after	adoption of amendments and this act becoming law."
21	Section	on 3. Effective Date. This act takes effect upon approval by the Governor or
22	upon its beco	ming law without such approval.
