A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend SL No. 11-33 to allow local revenue to support personnel cost of defunded non-degreed teachers and other defunded personnel in the state; reconcile budgets approval in SL No. 11-33 with recently available Amended Compact Grant Awards; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1	Section 1. <u>Purpose</u> . The purpose of this act is to appropriate operations budget
2	to support salaries of defunded teachers and other defunded personnel in the state;
3	reconciling the FY2016 Approved Budget with recently available Amended Compact
4	Sector Grant Awards; and correcting technical discrepancies in SL No. 11-33.
5	Section 2. Amendment. Kosrae State Law No. 11-33 is hereby amended at Title
6	Section 1, 2, 9, 10, 14 and 15 to read as follows:
7	"To appropriate the sum of \$9,590,897 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of
8	\$1,097,651 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,028,749 from the United States
9	Grant Fund; and the sum of \$70,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae
10	State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding
11	the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various
12	programs, and for other purposes."
