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

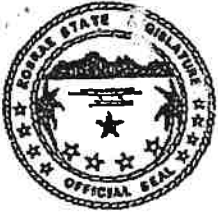

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,628,842 from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of \$1,031,848 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,026,249 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$50,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1           Section 1. Appropriations. Operation of the Executive. The sum of \$5,853,946, or so  
2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of  
3 \$ 528,717, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue  
4 Fund; the sum of \$970,040, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
5 United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$25,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
6 appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the  
7 fiscal year ending September 30,2016.

8           Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by Section  
9 1 of this act are apportioned as follows:

4           Kosrae State Court.
  - 5       (4) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 7 of this act is the Public Auditor.
  - 6       (5) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (1) of  
7           Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Broadcast Authority.
  - 8       (6) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (2) of  
9           Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Island Resource Management  
10          Authority.
  - 11       (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (4) of

- 20       Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is now allowed where the use of the  
21       reprogrammed funds would be: inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of



1 funds in the Amended Compact of Free Association and its related agreements. Reprogramming  
2 is now allowed where the use of reprogrammed funds would be used for activities not specified  
3 and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation the following is allowed:

4           (1) The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
5 apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other  
6 numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up  
7 to 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered  
8 subsection of Section 2 of this act to or from any other lettered object class within that same  
9 numbered subsection. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total  
10 amount apportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 12 of this act to or from any other  
11 numbered subsections of Section 12 of this act.

12           (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
13 apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 4 of this act to or from any other lettered  
14 object class within Section 4.

15           (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
16 apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 6 of this act to or from any other lettered  
17 object class within Section 6.

18           (4) The Public Auditor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
19 apportioned to any lettered object class within Section 8 of this act to or from any other lettered  
20 object class within Section 8.

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(5) Each allottee identified in numbered subsections of Section 10 of this act, or his designee, may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apportioned to any lettered object class of the numbered subsection of Section 10 for which he/she is the allottee, either to or from any other lettered object class of the same numbered subsection.

6 may allotted, obligated or expended to pay salary or benefits for a position, which is not  
7 established under this act and filled in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

8 Section 16. Reversion. Any portion of the sums appropriated by this act not obligated by  
9 September 30, 2016 reverts to the Fund from which appropriated, with the exception of funds  
10 appropriated under Section 11 of this act. Funds appropriated under Section 11 of this act shall  
11 not lapse.

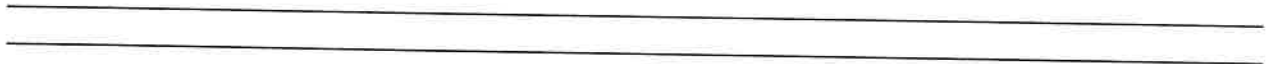
12 Section 17. Effective Date. This act shall become effective upon the approval of the  
13 Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
