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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$7,074,184 from the Amended Compact Fund, the sum of \$1,932,549 from the State Revenue Fund; the sum of \$1,020,755 from the United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$55,000 from the Foreign Assistance Fund of the Kosrae State Treasury for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the Kosrae State Government, its agencies, and various programs; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE KOSRAE STATE LEGISLATURE

1           Section 1. Appropriation. Operations of the Executive. The sum of \$6,056,088, or so  
2 much thereof as may be necessary, is appointed from the Amended Compact Fund; the sum of  
3 \$1,102,640, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Revenue  
4 Fund; the sum of \$978,931, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
5 United States Grant Fund; and the sum of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
6 appropriated from the Foreign Assistance Fund for the operation of the Executive Branch for the  
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2017.

8           Section 2. Apportionment. Operation of the Executive. The sums appropriated by Section  
9 1 of this act are apportioned as follows:

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1 (3) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 5 of this act is the Chief Justice of  
2 the Kosrae State Court.

3 (4) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 7 of this act is the Public Auditor.

4 (5) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (1)  
5 of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae Broadcast  
6 Authority.

7 (6) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (2)  
8 of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae Island Resource  
9 Management Authority.

10 (7) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (3)  
11 of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Kosrae Scholarship Board.

12 (8) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (4)  
13 of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Kosrae Visitors Bureau.

14 (9) The allottee of the funds appropriated by Section 9 and allocated under subsection (5)  
15 of Section 10 of this act is the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council.

16 Section 14. Reprogramming. Reprogramming is not allowed where the use of the  
17 reprogrammed funds would be inconsistent with the conditions or restrictions on the use of funds  
18 in the Amended Compact of Free Association and its related agreements or reprogrammed funds  
19 would be used for activities not specified and approved in the budget. Subject to this limitation  
20 the following is allowed:

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1           (1) The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
2 apporportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act either to or from any other  
3 numbered subsection of Section 2 of this act. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to  
4 10% of the total amount apporportioned to any lettered object class within a numbered subsection of  
5 Section 2 of this act to or from any other lettered object class within that same numbered  
6 subsection. The Governor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
7 apporportioned to any numbered subsection of Section 12 of this act to or from any other  
8 numbered subsections of Section 12 of this act.

9           (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
10 apporportioned to any lettered object class within Section 4 of this act to or from any other lettered  
11 object class within Section 4.

12           (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
13 apporportioned to any lettered object class within Section 6 of this act to or from any other lettered  
14 object class within Section 6.

15           (4) The Public Auditor or his designee may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount  
16 apporportioned to any lettered object class within Section 8 of this act to or from any other lettered  
17 object class within Section 8.

18           (5) Each allottee identified in numbered subsections of Section 10 of this act, or his  
19 designee, may reprogram up to 10% of the total amount apporportioned to any lettered object class

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1 of the numbered subsection of Section 10 for which he/she is the allottee, either to or from any  
2 other lettered object class of the same numbered subsection.

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
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1 Section 14. Effective Date. This act shall become law upon approval by the Governor or
