PUBLIC LAW NO. 10-140

AN ACT

To further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 205, to change the period of validity of regular passports from five years to ten years, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 205 of title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 205. Duration of passports. A regular passport shall be valid for a period of ten years from the date of issuance or renewal."

Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
